Surface Preparation	All surfaces must be clean, dry and free from all defective or poorly adhering material, dirt, grease and wax and be thoroughly rubbed down using suitable abrasive paper and dusted off. Remove all scale and rust by scraping with wire brushing or other conventional means. Previously painted surfaces that have loose or defective paint must be completely removed back to bare metal.			
Application Details	The normal recommendation is to apply one coat of Castle Paints Zinc Phosphate Primer followed by finishing coats. For improved finish on rough or textured surfaces two coats of Castle Paints Zinc Phosphate Primer is recommended. Fresh galvanised corrugated iron should be allowed to weather or first coated with a T-wash solution or Etch primer. Apply only in warm, dry weather.			
	Do not apply late in the day if there is a risk of fog or mist.
